

Dear Parents/Carers,

You may be aware from media coverage that the National Education Union has declared strike action, which will take place on Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May 2023. The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teachers' pay and conditions. It is not because of any issues at our school.

This letter is to provide you with as much notice as possible about our arrangements for Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May 2023:

On Thursday 27th April 2023

- Students in Years 7, 8 and 10 must attend school as usual.
- School will close at 2:30pm for students. There will be no lesson 6 or Enrichment sessions on this day.
- Students in Years 9 and 11 must remain at home and access learning on GCSEPod and Sparx Maths or revise for the upcoming examinations.
- Mr Gallagher will contact parents/carers of specific students in Years 9 and 11 who we would like to invite into school on this day.
- A packed lunch will be provided for students in Year 9 and 11 who are in receipt of free school meals. This will be given out as students leave school on Wednesday afternoon.

On Tuesday 2nd May 2023

- Students in Years 7, 9 and 11 must attend school as usual.
- School will close at 2:30pm for students. There will be no Enrichment sessions on this day.
- Students in Years 8 and 10 must remain at home and access learning on GCSEPod and Sparx maths.
- Mr Gallagher will contact parents/carers of specific students in Years 8 and 10 who we would like to invite into school on this day.
- Due to the Bank Holiday on Monday, a packed lunch will be provided for students in Year 8 and 10 who are in receipt of free school meals. This will be available from Reception from 11:30am to be collected.







I am sorry that some of you will have to make alternative arrangements for your child at short notice and that there will be some disruption to their education. I understand that this situation may be frustrating. We are working closely with union representatives to keep up to date with the situation and I will inform you as soon as possible of the arrangements for any future strike dates.
